

2019 - 2020 AHS/LFC PTSA Scholarships

The AHS/LFC PTSA Scholarships have been established to recognize students who have excelled during their high school career and are looking to continue their education post high school. The AHS/LFC PTSA is offering four categories of scholarships so that students can choose which scholarship is of interest. Students may submit one scholarship application. A minimum of four scholarships, in the amount of \$1000 each, will be awarded to college-bound students graduating from Allen High School's Class of 2020. The applicant must plan to enroll full-time at an accredited college/university or technical school. The scholarships will be presented at the Senior Awards ceremony on Thursday, May 7, 2020.

Four scholarship categories have been established for students to apply. Students are encouraged to apply for one scholarship that best reflects their background, experience, and interest. Students may submit one scholarship application for one category.

- Completed and signed application by student and parent acknowledging all information on application is accurate and true to the best of your knowledge.
- Letter of recommendation as specified on each of the four scholarship categories
- Copy of Allen High School transcript. Please make sure it is the most current transcript available.
- Responses to the following requests for information on summary form and essay. Responses will be evaluated on clear and concise thoughts, elaboration, content, grammar, spelling and overall impact. Additionally, please double space the responses, use 14 pt. Arial font, and adhere to the 500 word count on the essay.

- Minimum GPA 2.8
- Include Transcript
- Include Recommendation Letter from a teacher, counselor, employer, or adult family friend
- Essay: Describe your adversities and how you have overcome them. Please include why continuing your post high school education is important and what this means to you. (500 word count)

- **EAGLES GIVING BACK**

This scholarship is for the student who has been involved in community service and philanthropic organizations.

- Minimum GPA 3.0
- Include Transcript
- Complete Community Service Summary Form
- Include Recommendation Letter from someone who could attest to your impact in the community through your service to their organization
- Essay: How did your volunteer service make an impact in your life and those you have served? Please include 1-2 examples. (500 word count)

- **EAGLE SPIRIT OF AHS**

This scholarship is for the student who has actively been involved in at least one AISD recognized Official Club, UIL Activity, and/or Sport for a minimum of 2 years.

- Minimum GPA 3.0
- Include Transcript
- Complete the Club/Activities Summary Form
- Include Recommendation Letter from a club sponsor or coach of the extracurricular activity you have been involved
- Essay: Describe the importance of being involved in your school community and how it has impacted your life. (500 word count)

- **OUTSTANDING EAGLE**

This scholarship is for the student who has excelled academically.

- Minimum GPA 4.0
- Include Transcript
- Include Official ACT/SAT Scores
- Complete Academic & Awards Summary Form
- Include Recommendation Letter from an educator (teacher, counselor, principal, sponsor, coach, staff at AHS)
- Essay: In the words of Bo Bennett “ A dream becomes a goal when action is taken toward its achievement.” During the past four years at AHS, you have achieved academic excellence. Reflect on your educational journey and share your academic goals, challenges, opportunities, and actions that led to your achievement. (500 word count)
